Dear Mrs. Westbrook:

Our staff has made a preliminary review of the Fisher Robinson Cemetery marker application. We applaud your efforts to save the early burial ground and to tell a part of the county's history that would otherwise have been lost. However, we need some additional information before we can pass the application on to the State Marker Committee. Any material you can supply regarding the following items would be appreciated.

1. Who was Fisher Robinson? Where and when was he born? When did he die? What was his occupation? Etc.
2. Since some of the individuals buried at the site were known to others in the area, could we have a list of burial dates? If the exact date is not known, an approximate date would help.
3. Is it certain that the cemetery was associated with the early church?
4. Approximately how many graves have been located?
5. When did Fisher Robinson donate the land for use as a cemetery?

We look forward to having this historic site marked, but we need more information to fill in the gaps. Any assistance you can provide will be beneficial to the committee's evaluation.
