Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of the Henderson County Levee Improvement District No. Three ("Levee District") will meet on Wednesday, December 4, 2019 at 2:00 p.m. at the Justice of the Peace Office, 1700 E. Royall Blvd., Malakoff, Texas, to consider the following:

1. Call to Order.

4. Opportunity for citizens to express items of concern.

Citizens appearing during this time will be allowed to present their concern and are limited to a three-minute time period; however, the Board of Directors are prohibited from entering into deliberations, and then the item may be referred to a future agenda for discussion.

5. Consider and approve minutes for the meeting of August 14, 2019.
6. Discuss financial accounts and status of the Levee District.
7. Discuss and consider approval of 2018 audit prepared by Smith, Lambright & Associates.
8. Discuss and consider awarding of contract for repair/installation of fences on the levees owned by the Levee District; further discuss and consider payment for any contract that is awarded.
9. Discuss and consider payment of bills.
