Birth Record FAQs

How do I get a copy of my birth certificate?

- 1. To get a copy of your birth certificate from Henderson County Clerk's Office, you must have been born in the state of Texas.
- 2. Be a properly qualified applicant i.e. Self, Immediate family member, his or her legal guardian or representative. Please see Section 181.1(21) of the Texas Administrative Code for more details.

Present identification consistent with the following identification:

- Driver's license from a U.S. state
- Federal or state ID card
- Military ID card
- U.S. passport

All primary identification documents must be current and valid. In the absence of primary identification view <u>Texas DSHS-Vitals</u> for complete details.

- 3. There will be a Birth Request Form to fill out in office.
- 4. Pay fee of \$23.00. We accept cash, check or card (convenience fee for using a card).

Mail in Request

If you are unable to order in person:

- 1. Fill out Birth Certificate request form and Notarized proof of affidavit.
- 2. Copy of valid I.D./ D.L.
- 3. Fee of \$23.00 (check or money order)
