Eligibility:

Residence: Must live in Henderson County

<u>Household</u>: A CIHCP household is a person living alone or two or more persons living together where legal responsibility for support exists. Excluding disqualified persons. A disqualified person is one who receives or is categorically eligible to receive Medicaid.

Resources: A household is eligible if the total countable resources do not exceed \$2,000. If a household has a disabled or aged person that meets relationship requirement, resources cannot exceed \$3,000.

Income: Monthly net income not to exceed 21% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines.

Medical Need: Must have a medical necessity to obtain services.

Counties must provide these basic health care services:

- (1) Primary and preventative services designed to meet the needs of the community, including:
 - (A) immunizations;
 - (B) medical screening services; and
 - (C) annual physical examinations;
- (2) Inpatient and outpatient hospital services at ETMC Athens;
- (3) Rural health clinics;
- (4) Laboratory and X-ray services;
- (5) Family planning services;
- (6) Physician services for doctors in Henderson County;
- (7) Up to three (3) prescription drugs a month;
